A RESOLUTION PROVIDING THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COFFEY COUNTY, KANSAS, SHALL CAUSE ITS FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND FINANCIAL REPORTS OF THE SAID MUNICIPALITY TO BE PREPARED ON THE BASIS OF CASH RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS AS ADJUSTED TO SHOW COMPLIANCE WITH THE CASH BASIS AND BUDGET LAWS OF THIS STATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Coffey County, Kansas (hereinafter "the Board"), has determined that the financial statements and financial reports for the year ended 2019 to be prepared in conformity with the requirements of K.S.A. 75-1120a(a) are not relevant to the requirements of the cash basis and budget laws of this State and are of no significant value to the Board, or the member of the general public of Coffey County, Kansas (hereinafter "the County"); and

WHEREAS, there are no revenue bond ordinances or other ordinances or resolutions of said municipality which require financial statements and financial reports to be prepared in conformity with said act for the year ended 2019.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COFFEY COUNTY, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That in regular meeting duly assembled this date, said Board requests the Director of Accounts and Reports to waive the requirements of said law as they apply to Coffey County, Kansas, for the year 2019.

2. That said Board shall cause its financial statements and financial reports of the said municipality to be prepared on the basis of cash receipts and disbursements as adjusted to show compliance with the cash basis and budget laws of this State.
