

Burlington Middle School Back to School night

BURLINGTON — The Burlington Middle School will host a Back to School night Tuesday, Aug. 18 at the school.



Due to the coronavirus pandemic, the night will look different than past years. Times and specific locations for each grade are listed below.

Students whose last name begins with A-E will attend 6 to 6:30 p.m. Students with a last name beginning with F-M will attend 6:30 to 7 p.m.; and students with a last name beginning with N-Z will attend 7 to 7:30 p.m.

Fifth- and sixth-grade students will enter through the

front entrance of BMS to receive their schedules. Seventh- and eighth-grade students will enter through the North commons (the back of the building) to receive their schedules.

While at the middle school, please follow these guidelines: Everyone will need to wear a mask while in the building; students will be able to put their supplies in their locker; students (and parents) may walk their schedule as needed and BMS staff will be available to assist; please be respectful of the time provided and limit your time in the building to 10 to 15 minutes; to limit the number of people in the building, only one parent/guardian should attend with their child or children.

The \$1,545 second-place prize went to the No. 25 team, Bucher and Bucher, who caught five fish with a total weight of 44.20 pounds. The \$925 third-place prize went to team No. 1, Scarberry and Eigenman, who caught five fish with a total weight of 43.80 pounds. Fourth place, and \$620, went to team No. 13, Nolan and Nolan, who caught five fish weighing a total of 43.45 pounds. Fifth place went to team No. 38, Hechathorn and Panches, who caught five fish weighing a total of 40.20 pounds. They received \$310.
