Lebo bests Burlingame

Volleyball teams from Hartford, Lebo, Southern Coffey County and Waverly high schools were in action Tuesday, Oct. 6. Hartford hosted Madison and Marais des Cygnes Valley, while Waverly hosted SCC and Olpe. Lebo played Burlingame and Northeast Kansas Home School at Burlingame.

At Burlingame, the Lebo Lady Wolves picked up a pair of wins. They topped Burlingame in a two-set nail biter, winning the first set 26-24 and the second 25-23. They defeated Northeast Kansas Home School in three sets. They won the first set 25-12 but fell in the second, 14-25. In the third set, Lebo claimed the win 25-20, thus winning the match.

At Waverly, the SCC Lady Titans split, while the Waverly Lady Bulldogs dropped two tough matches. SCC bested Waverly in three sets, falling 20-25 in the first set but coming back to win the second, 25-21, and the third, 25-23. In addition to their loss to SCC, Waverly also fell to Olpe, 22-25, 17-25.

On the evening for SCC, Josie Weers topped the leaderboard in kills with 21, while Ross Snovelle had 12 and Kyra Ohl six. Weers made 13 blocks, Madeline Spencer made nine and Snovelle made seven. Leaders in digs were Emersyn Hall with eight, Ohl and Taryn Lather with four each and Spencer with three. Spencer had 23 assists, Callie Johnson 16 and Weers one. Ohl had both of the team's aces.

At Hartford, the Lady Jaguars also took a pair of losses. Against Madison, they fell 18-25 in the first set, then battled back to win the second, 25-22. They were edged in the third set, 25-27. They also dropped a

close match to MdcV in two sets, 23-25, 21-25.

Prior to Tuesday's matches, SCC also competed in a tournament at Chanute. They went 2-3, earning wins over Chanute, 27-25, 25-17, and Coffeyville, 25-10, 25-14. They fell to Erie, 22-25, 25-12, 18-25; Girard, 17-25, 12-25; and, in a rematch, Chanute, 17-25, 10-25. The Lady Titans placed fourth in the tournament.

On the day, Weers led in kills with 47, followed by Snovelle with 19 and Ohl with 10. Snovelle had 10 blocks, Weers eight and Spencer four. Leading in digs were Hall with 42, Lather with 17 and Weers with 15. Leading in assists were Johnson with 36, Spencer with 35 and Ohl with two. Weers and Snovelle each had four aces, Johnson and Hall each had three and Spencer and Ohl each had two.

All four teams concluded

their regular-season Lyon County League runs Tuesday, Oct. 13. Lebo hosted Hartford and SCC, while Waverly played MdcV and non-league opponent Herington

at Melvern. The next action for all four teams will be the Lyon County League Tournament, but details for the tournament were not available at press time.
