Board approves district insurance bid, SPARK funds

BURLINGTON — The Burlington USD 244 Board of Education met in special session Monday evening, Oct. 26. The board approved two motions in the brief, 10-minute meeting. After rejecting all original bids for the district insurance proposal at the regular monthly meeting Oct. 10, the district released the specifications with a deadline of Friday, Oct. 16, and received a bid from TrustPoint Insurance for property and for workers compensation and a bid from the Kansas As-

sociation of School Boards (KASB) Risk Management for workers compensation. The board unanimously approved a motion to accept the bid from TrustPoint Insurance for property and casualty in the amount of \$142,663 and the bid from TrustPoint Insurance for workers compensation in the amount of \$55,397, for a total of \$198,060. In the second approval, the board accepted \$176,028 in SPARK funds from Coffey County for COVID-19 related expenditures. That

motion also carried unanimously. Six of the seven board members were present for the meeting, with Monique Hart and Michael Thorp attending in person and Stacy Augustyn, James Higgins, Lucas Allen and Selena King attending via StarLeaf. Also attending in person were Superintendent Craig Marshall, Board Clerk Tracey Moerer and three representatives from TrustPoint Insurance, Angela Trimble, Kimberly Skillman-Robrahm and Sarah Rice.
